We are happy to be having our Modern Showcase at the Hands All Around Quilt Show **April 28**th **and 29**th. This is a wonderful collaboration between the two quilt guilds. Not only will we need your quilts to display, but we will need helpers at the show for setup and helping answer questions of quilt show attendees.

We have setup a <u>Signup genius</u> to make it easy for everyone to pick a timeslot that is convenient for them. BNMQG volunteers will get into the Quilt Show for free. Please thank the Hands All Around Quilt Guild members for their hospitality. Quilts will be collected at the BNMQG April meeting.



Community Outreach

We currently have 4 quilts that need a quilt backing and have long arm quilters willing to quilt them. If you have fabric that could be used for a quilt backing that you are willing to donate, please bring to the April meeting.

So far, **39** quilts have been delivered to the <u>Illinois CancerCare</u>, **3** completed quilt tops on hand, **3** tops need to be quilted, **2** more are ready to be bound, **3** are at the volunteer quilters, all from the **420** blocks made by members.

Many people took blocks or quilt tops home from previous meetings, so hoping to see more quilt tops or completed quilts by the January meeting.



If you have blocks or tops, could you please text or email Pat S? We are trying to figure out if we need more backing fabric or batting. Pat's contact info is in the <u>Member's Page</u>.

Pat S. is happy to arrange a meeting - this is true for dropping off completed blocks, quilts or quilt tops. We also still have some blocks for those interested in making quilt tops.

We are happy to take donations of leftover fabric to add to quilt tops for negative space with the blocks. We will also accept donations of batting and backing fabric.

There will be a separate prize drawing for those that put together a quilt top out of the blocks, quilt a quilt top or bind a completed top. If you do all 3 things, you will get your name in the drawing 3 times!


