Our Raffle quilt will be appearing at some area guild meetings (HAAQG and Decatur), as well as at ARC and other local quilt shops. More details soon.






June 10th Dyeing Workshops with Vickie A.



Vickie A. is bringing her dyeing workshops to BNMQG! She is offering **two different** workshops all on the same day! In the morning, you will be working with soy wax and thickened dyes. Donna came from a sewing family, as both her mother and grandmother were seamstresses. Donna started by creating simple garments without a pattern before the age of 10. She then went on to 4-H and learned the art of making a whole range of clothes from simple to very complex. She majored in Home Economics in College and once she had her family, she spent her time dabbling in sewing. When her youngest went to school she went back to work full-time and taught home economics in high school. The last three years of her teaching career, she taught her students how to make quilts. She has always been drawn to modern fabrics and worked at a fabric store called Sew Much More. It's here she met Betty and Connie and she became one of the founding members of the BNMQG. Donna has done trunk shows and workshops on modern quilts and improv throughout Illinois. She remains an active member of BNMQG.
