

We are greeted every month with "Hello Modern Quilters"! That is the voice of our president, leader and dear friend Lisa Baermann. Lisa started crafting at the age of seven with the help of her grandmother, who taught her how to crochet. She made her first rag quilt in 2005. Shortly after in 2007 she bought an Embroidery Combo machine and proceeded to do a lot of embroidery on clothes and bags. Lisa then decided to make a traditional baby quilt. It was a simple pattern of sewing squares to squares and included embroidery, but she was hooked. It was then that she shifted from embroidery to quilting. She made her first panel quilt, The Very Hungry Caterpillar, and quilted it on her domestic machine. She knew there had to be an easier way and bought her first longarm in 2013, and



followed that with an upgrade in 2019. Initially, Lisa was an internet quilter through Missouri Star Quilting Forum. She joined the HAAQG with Nancy Powell. They were then recruited by Betty Woodruff and joined the BNMQG in 2016. Lisa considers herself a modern traditionalist quilter but with the encouragement of Nancy and other modern quilters she is challenging herself to become more modern. I think I can speak for all of us when I say I am very grateful that Lisa joined the BNMQG. We will miss her guidance but I know she will continue to influence our guild in the months and years ahead. We have been blessed with her leadership, her smile and her continued support. "Thanks so much, Lisa!"

2023-2024 BNMQG Membership



Can you believe it is time to renew your BNMQG Membership? Time is flying by! You can bring your <u>membership form</u> and check to the August meeting. All members need to complete a new membership form.

Please renew before October 31^{st} – at that point you will be removed from the Facebook group and will no longer receive emails (including zoom invitations) that are sent to members.

Membership fee will be \$45 starting with the 2023-24 guild year. The board is considering an amendment to the bylaws to remove the half year membership option.

10 years ago, our fees started out at \$25, were raised to \$30 in 2015, then in 2018 the fee became \$35.

In these last 5 years, speaker fees have increased dramatically. What was once \$150 - \$200 is now \$300 - \$500 (and even more for some of the really in demand programs).
