## MQG: Quilt Block Studies ...

It's almost Halloween! I hope you are ready for all things spooky! It's also time for another Block Study reveal! This month I did the Organic Diamonds block. This is a paper pieced block that I found challenging, but once I got it, I was thrilled with the results. You can find it in the MQG Resource Library by searching Organic Diamond, or search by the Category Quilt Block Studies.

What is Paper piecing? It's a type of foundation piecing where you sew patches of fabric directly onto a paper template. It gives you precision that allows you to be extremely accurate. This way, you can perfectly replicate blocks to make an entire quilt! Here is my favorite MQG

paper piecing video tutorial, Paper Piecing Tips and Tricks by Elizbeth Dackson.



## Double Wedding Ring Quilts: Traditions Made Modern

by Victoria Findlay Wolfe Foreword by Roderick Kirakofe

We first came to know Victoria Findlay Wolfe (VFW) and her work at the first QuiltCon in 2013 in Austin, TX. Victoria entered a modern adaptation of the unique Double Wedding Ring pattern that originated in the early part of the 20th Century. She won Best of Show with her interpretation titled, "Double Edged Love". This quilt originated from a quilt she made, but didn't like. It was subsequently cut up and formed many of the pieces for this first Wedding Ring. Twelve Wedding Ring quilts later, Victoria had inserted memories of visits to her grandparents in MN, demonstrated her strong interest in traditional patterns made modern, and had pushed the boundaries of the pattern, while never forgetting the history of past quiltmakers. What strikes me most about her textiles is how she is able to tell stories in these stunning, completely modern statements.



<u>Double Wedding Ring Quilts</u> inspires us, as quiltmakers, to work like visual artists and explore a theme, work in a series, and push ourselves to learn and make mistakes.

VF Wolfe's first book, 15 Minutes of Play, encouraged us to "make fabric" with time spent at our machines each day exploring improv piecing. Double Wedding Ring Quilts: Traditions Made Modern includes the 12 quilts in her series, encouraging words from the author, variations of this beloved pattern, and anecdotes of Victoria's life and creative process. There are included paper templates for the Wedding Ring and VFW also has acrylic templates available.

Whether you ever make a Wedding ring or not, the desire to create personal modern

statements while never forgetting our collective quilt history is worthy of exploration and planning. Find space for this book in your quilt library. You might be inspired to carve out some time for research of a classic pattern and then apply modern quilting
