February 27th: Quiltcon Honorees:


There is a change in our February meeting. Since we have five of our members quilts being accepted to Quiltcon, the board thought it would be great to hear more from our member honorees.

Kona Challenge:



meetings. The quilt top is finished and I've sent it to be quilted. This was my first paper piece project and I found it funstrating (fun + frustrating) and that I learned a lot from it. Seeing the design emerge was incredibly satisfying and fun. This is why I love the Resource Library, I find their patterns challenging and educational. I can't wait to share the finished quilt with everyone!

Book Thoughts by Jamie Willis Inspirational Read –Jamie Willis Quilts & Crafts Issue #34 Quarterly published by Quiltmania



This issue was published in the fall of 2023 and I recently revisited the contents and was immediately inspired (again)! The editorial sets the tone of the issue. Editor, Carol Veillon, again reinforces that even with the high cost of publishing, nothing comes close to a highquality inspiring and educational magazine printed on great paper. This issue sticks to those standards.


The first 20 pages are devoted to inspiring quilts from all categories of the 2023 Festival of Quilts in Birmingham, England. I enjoyed seeing a nod to the

many genres of modern and art quilts. Everything from abstract portraits, millefiori, and curves to make one envious. Joe Cunningham was given his own solo show at the Festival and he explains how he developed his unique style after spending years studying and reproducing traditional 19th Century quilts. This really resonates with many of us modern quilters.

English quilter, Miesje Chafer, is featured and she adapts some of her original modern pieces to needlepoint. Along with a portrait of Patricia Perez-Canto Caffrey, there are 10 projects with templates, great directions & coloring sheets for each. I don't know about you, but I love a good coloring sheet for a quilt! Individual issues are available from Quiltmania if you don't want a full subscription.
